Babysitting Guidelines

1. Babysitting hours are: (*Hours are subject to change at anytime)

Mon – Fri Day: 9:00am – 1:00pm Mon - Thurs Eve: 5:00pm - 7:00pm Sat Morn: 9:00am-11:00am

2. Parents are required to fill out paperwork on each child to be kept on file.

3. Parents are to sign each child in and sign them out when they are picked up.

4. Payment is to be made to the Babysitter when child(ren) are dropped off.
\$2 first child, \$1 each additional child.

5. Children can be left with Babysitter ONLY while the parent is on the premises working out or having therapy in the PT building.

6. To protect the health and safety of all children, please do not bring children to babysitting when they are ill:

*green runny nose, fever within the past 24 hours, cough, stomach ache, diarrhea within the past 24 hours, antibiotics within the past 48 hours.

* Babysitter has the right to refuse to watch your child if any symptoms are present.

7. Children can bring with them small toys, snacks, and drinks, but they are to be responsible for their own items and remember to take them home. If the toy brought becomes an issue, it will be taken away and returned upon departure.

8. Should a child require a diaper change, the parent will be asked to stop exercise/therapy to change their child and must take the soiled diaper with them. Babysitters will not change diapers.

9. Discipline Policy for Unacceptable Behavior:

1st Offense: Verbal warning to child.

2nd Offense: Verbal warning to child, parent notified.

3rd Offense: Written warning given to parent.

4th Offense: Your child will be asked to not return to babysitting.

**NOTE: We do not refund memberships.*

10. Babysitting is for children ages 0-7. An older child may stay in the babysitting room during babysitting hours AS LONG AS he/she is not disruptive or harmful in anyway (actions or words) to younger children or to the babysitter. The Babysitter has the right to refuse an older child to the babysitting room due to unacceptable behavior or to an already full room.

11. Children are not permitted in the babysitting room without a staff member present in the room. When school is cancelled, morning babysitting is also cancelled. (Please call DVHS at 296-1850 #1 to find out if school is closed or delayed). Please call the Fitness Center to see if evening babysitting will be available on a cancelled school day.

12. If there should be a 2 hour delay, babysitting will start at 10:30am. If there is a cancellation of after-school activities, please call the Fitness Center to check on evening babysitting.

13. Should your child get injured while in babysitting an accident report will be filled out. A copy will be given to the parent and one kept on file. First aid will be given if necessary.
